SEE TO IT Colossians 2:8

Today as you sit and read this article, Carla and I want to encourage and challenge us to remember the call laid before us from Colossians 2:8. "See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition."

I don't know about you, but as Carla and I see the current temperature of our culture, it sometimes feels like a pressure cooker about to either explode or implode on itself. Demands to jettison truth and to redefine biblical definitions of good and evil are pressing inward on the family and on our kids. The desire to take captive the thoughts of people has never felt more present in our generation than it does now.

As Christians, families, and married couples, we have a clear challenge from God's Word to both stand for and teach truth. Psalm 78:4 calls us to "tell the coming generation" of the "glorious deeds of the Lord." However, teaching the coming generation in the midst of a world waging a battle for the soul can at times can bring anger and frustration out of us.

Do not forget - we are not alone. Many believers throughout history have been surrounded by cultures directly opposed to faith in Jesus and to his ways. Our Lord has been and will be faithful to his people in every circumstance (1 Thess. 5:23-24). As we trust him to lead us in these times, we can receive daily guidance over our interactions and conversations through Colossians 4:2-6. "Continue steadfastly in prayer...walk in wisdom toward outsiders... let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt."

Church, we must be careful not to be taken captive, but to stand firmly on God's Word and defend our children and the coming generation from the empty and destructive philosophy of this present age. We must do this by remembering the vital nature of personal time in God's Word. We must also let our words be governed by prayer and graciousness, so that as we train our kids and the next generation to stand firm and live well, we are not speaking or leading in anger, pride, or frustration, but in truth and love.

We do all this "by the strength that God supplies—in order that in everything God may be glorified through Christ Jesus" (1 Peter 4:11).

We love you all and feel so blessed to be running the race alongside each of you!



SHANNON HAMLETT


Through Central Missionary Clearing House at Texas Tech in Lubbock, TX, Shannon hosts
